We recognise that when the person you care for dies, it can be a difficult time, filled with complex and conflicting emotions. The loss includes the end of your caring role, which may affect your sense of purpose.

Carers Leeds offers one-to-one bereavement support, in person, on the telephone and on Zoom, if you have lost someone you were caring for, typically where this loss has occurred within the last two years. We also run a monthly bereavement support group – a safe space for discussing and processing grief.
